The larger buildings were constructed in the Spanish Renaissance style of architecture, and were finished in Ivory, coated with a dull white tint that gave the name of Ivory City to the grounds. There were also State buildings erected by Illinois, Maryland, Missouri, New York, and Pennsylvania, city buildings representing Cincinnati and Philadelphia, and special structures devoted to the exhibits of Cuba, Porto Rico, and Guatemala. The grounds were adorned with statuary, among them six original historical groups, situated in the Court of Palaces, and including The Aztec, by Louis A. Gudebrod; The Negro, by Charles A.
