

Simmons-Harris, by a 5-4 margin, upheld the constitutionality of a school voucher program that gives tuition assistance to poor children in failing public schools in Cleveland to enable them to attend private schools in the city, notwithstanding that most of the schools are religious in nature. In so doing the Court substantially loosened the constraints that apply to voucher programs under the establishment of religion clause. At issue in the case was Ohio s Pilot Scholarship Program, which provides up to \$2250 to poor students in kindergarten through the eighth grade in Cleveland for use at private schools in the city. Eighty percent of those schools are religious, and most of the voucher children (96) attend the religious schools. The Court's prior decisions addressing the constitutionality of indirect aid Committee for Public Education v. Nyquist, Mueller v. Allen, Witters v. Washington Department of Social Services for the Blind, and Zobrest v. Catalina Foothills Public Schools seemed to suggest that a voucher program would pass constitutional muster...
